- Flight Line We need to work on the control of our flight line. There should only
 be a spotter, air boss and the pilot at the flightline when a pilot is flying. Having
 extra people at the flight line talking while the pilots are flying, the pilots may not
 hear the instructions from the air boss or the spotter and may cause confusion
 for the pilots.
- 2. If we see an RC jet/plane landing far from the runway, or lands in the grass, and the pilot has issues walking, the spotter should help the pilot to retrieve his aircraft.
